Dear GWGC Members and Prospective GWGC Members,

It's that time again to renew your GWGC membership and encourage new members to join our Ladies Golf Club.

Membership in the GWGC allows you to play in our 18-hole tournaments, post tournament and non-tournament scores and maintain your handicap. We are informally known as the "Thursday Group" because our tournaments have reserved tee times on Thursday mornings. But you can play in the tournaments any day of the week (except Tuesdays), as long as you play with another member. So even if you work on Thursdays, you can be an active member of the club.

Attached is a membership application for 2022. We have held the 18-hole membership fee at \$90. You may also elect to participate in the Hole-in-One Club for an additional \$2. Your hole-in-one can occur during any round at the Griff during the GWGC playing season.

Please note as per the directions on the application, there are options for renewing one's membership. You may mail your check and application or you may renew through the LeaderBoard System. On LeaderBoard, you may renew your membership, update your information, and pay by a credit card without filling out an application. If you are a new member, please use the mail option.

We also welcome 9-holers to join the GWGC and to play on Thursday mornings. If you are joining the nine-holers, please be aware that our rules require that at least six 9-hole members play to hold a tournament and to award prizes for that day. In the past few seasons, we have not had enough 9-holers playing to actually hold tournaments but we have had 9-holers playing for fun. This season the membership fee for 9-holers will again be \$50 plus an optional \$2 for the Hole-in-One Club.

Our Opening Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 7, 2022 with details to follow. Our Opening Tournament Day is set for Thursday, April 14, 2022.

We welcome all new members and please not to worry about where one's golfing skills are at the moment. The list of things to remember are to bring a set of golf clubs, maintain the pace of play, and have fun while learning the game of golf. You do not have to be a Greenwich resident to be a member of the GWGC and play in GWGC events. Please forward this letter with the attachments to your golfing friends.
